## Black Fly Control Person needed

Monitor streams/brooks for black fly larvae.

Treat streams if larvae found using Molloy-Struble formulas.

Seasonal paid position.....March 1<sup>st</sup> to July 31<sup>st</sup> .....\$10.43/hour. 10-20 hours/week.

Free 30 hour pesticide training course given for eligibility for state exam.

Town of Caroga pays for state pesticide exam (\$100).

Town of Caroga pays for your state pesticide license after you pass the exam (\$450).

Town of Caroga pays for your equipment and rubber boots.

Lots of walking thru the woods in the spring & summer. Lots of bushwacking.

Maintain treatment & monitoring records for your streams and submit reports every 2 weeks.

Submit accurate and truthful time sheets and mileage sheets.

Work your own hours monitoring and treating your assigned streams.

Help eliminate those biting black flies before they annoy you and your neighbors.
